This month our new 48 Hours pairing take a visit to one of the country's most famous and prolific venues in the heart of Surrey.

This month we find ourselves on a beautiful old estate lake set in the Surrey hills. Located off the A25 near Dorking, the Old Lake at Old Bury Hill Fisheries is a 12-acre lake surrounded by mature trees and stunning scenery. There is a fantastic head of carp in the Old Lake with stock numbering in excess of 800, ranging from low-doubles to over 30lb, with numerous 20lb+ specimens to be caught. All swims have been purpose-built with platforms giving good disabled access, so the use of a rod pod is essential. Also on site are a very well stocked tackle shop and a café. Old Bury Hill offers something different to your average day ticket fishery, as you can hire a punt to set sail around the lake to fish for the carp.
